02. CCTV Quotation – Severn Centre

Quotation Received from Tech Services for a new system at the Severn Centre which would link the system into the Parish Council system. Quote from £14,206.66 . **RESOLVED** to accept quotation

03. Planning –Application under Section 73A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for the retrospective change of use of land to caravan park to include the siting of one glamping pod; 8 touring caravan pitches; erection of toilet/shower block; conversion of (part of) existing dwelling to form one holiday let property; formation of on-site roads

RESOLVED to object on the grounds that the access road down to the site is narrow and in a poor condition. It is not suitable for the increased flow and type of traffic that this development would generate.

The application does not note that the whole length of the access track is Highley Public Footpath 0127/15/6, part of the Severn Way Long-Distance Footpath, which is a very well used footpath. The proposed site would be visible from this footpath . This applicant has stated that this site cannot be seen from any Public Footpath which is incorrect.
